## **Chapter 403. Administration**

#### Section 403.42

(f) A building code official may issue an annual permit instead of an individual permit for each alteration to an already approved electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing installation. All of the following are required:

A building code official may issue an annual permit instead of an individual permit for repairs & maintenance to an already approved electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing installation. All of the following are required:

- (1) The applicant shall regularly employ at least one qualified trades person in the building or structure owned or operated by the applicant.
- (2) The applicant shall submit an application in accordance with § 403.42a (m).
- (3) An annual permit holder shall keep detailed records of alterations made in accordance with the annual permit. The permit holder shall provide access to these records to the building code official.
- (4) A separate permit must be acquired for any alterations or replacement of existing systems.

## **Requirements for Annual Permit**

Manufacturing facilities and institutions such as hospitals and universities that regularly perform repairs & maintenance on approved electrical, gas, mechanical and plumbing installations may apply for a single UCC permit that will allow these repairs & maintenance to be made over a 12-month period.

The Municipality will issue an Annual Permit as long as the following conditions are met:

1. The specified installation(s) shall have been approved for code compliance under a previously issued occupancy permit.

### 2. Submission requires the following:

- 2 copies of the "APPLICATION FOR ANNUAL PERMIT" legibly completed and signed
- Site Drawing if the specific building is in at a multi structure facility to better define which structure
- \$4.50 DCED State fee
- \$75.00 Administrative Fee and
- \$110.00 per Trade (i.e. Electrical, Gas, Mechanical, Plumbing) made payable to PMCA (check or money order)
- 3. A separate application is required for each covered building, structure or premises.
- 4. The owner or operator of the building, structure or premises where the repairs & maintenance will take place must certify that the persons performing the work are normally employed at this site and are "qualified tradespersons," because they meet one of the following requirements:
  - They have performed similar repairs & maintenance on the specified systems for at least three (3) years prior to making application; or,
  - They hold a Journeyman's card in an applicable trade, or are registered apprentices working under the direct supervision of a Journeyman; or,
  - They hold a certification or other qualification issued by the Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry, another U.S. state, a national model code agency, a national standards writing organization, or a national association representing persons who work in the electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing industries.
- 5. The permit holder must agree to maintain detailed records of all repairs & maintenance made under the permit and to make these available, upon request, to Municipal construction code officials.
- 6. The \$110.00 per trade fee includes the permit approval and one hour of evaluation time. Additional evaluation time or inspections as may be required will be based on our hourly fee or rate schedule at a cost not to exceed the normal prices as stated in the fee schedule for the municipality.
